Dear Parents,

Thank you for taking the time to look at our School Bus Guide. We have produced this guide to provide an overview of the proposed school bus route, and to provide further details, including timetable and fare information. Bookings for the route can be made via the dedicated transport website at cavendishschool.vectare.co.uk. This website allows you to enter your postcode, find your closest stop, and see bespoke travel information for your child's journey to school.

The website allows for bookings to be made 24/7 from anywhere in the world, meaning that if you need to leave early for work one morning or you're running late and you would like your child to travel on the school bus as a one-off, you can make a booking. Late notice bookings are subject to availability, so we advise making a booking as early as possible.

We have tried to ensure that journey times remain as short as possible.


All stops on the network will only be served if there is parental demand.

The route will be operated by bus drivers who are subject to safer recruitment checks by The Cavendish School, giving you peace of mind for your child's safety. In addition, the route also has a chaperone, who will also assist the children in boarding and alighting.





Terms & Conditions

1. This agreement is made between all school bus passengers, parents and The Cavendish School in order to provide safe, comfortable and civilised journeys for all passengers.
2. Arrangements for pupils' journeys to and from school are the responsibility of their parents. To assist with discharging this responsibility, The Cavendish School provides a school bus service.
3. Transport on the school bus service must be arranged in advance. Journeys are recorded and will be charged in arrears on the termly fees invoice.
4. The school bus service is available to pupils from Nursery to Year 6.
5. Once a session is booked, no refund is available in the event of cancellation or a pupil failing to travel; however, please inform the school if a child will not be travelling on a booked journey and/or cancel on the Vectare app or website.
6. Bookings are to be made via cavendishschool.vectare.co.uk.
7. Each pupil for whom an online form has been submitted will be added to a list detailing the journey they are booked to travel on and their bus stop. The list for each journey will be checked by the chaperone.
8. No pupil is permitted to travel on the school bus service if not pre-booked for that bus.
9. Pupils must travel to and from The Cavendish School in full school uniform.
10. Pupils should be at the bus stop 5 minutes before the scheduled time of departure to ensure they do not miss the bus. Drivers will not wait past the scheduled departure time.
11. Good conduct is required at all times. Shouting, use of inappropriate language, dropping litter, playing loud music, use of electronic devices or any other misbehaviour is strictly forbidden, as is eating on the bus. Pupils are expected to behave responsibly on transport to and from The Cavendish School.
12. Except when embarking or disembarking, all passengers must remain seated with their seat belts fastened correctly.
13. Whilst on a school bus, all passengers must accept the authority of the chaperone or driver, who may ask them to obey any reasonable instruction such as pick up litter, cease certain actions or move to a different seat.
14. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in the matter being referred to the pupil's class teacher or the Head and may result in disciplinary action, including temporary or permanent withdrawal of permission to use the school bus service.
15. The Cavendish School aims for 95% of journeys to operate within the transport industry window of tolerance of one minute early to five minutes late. However, timings may vary due to traffic conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
