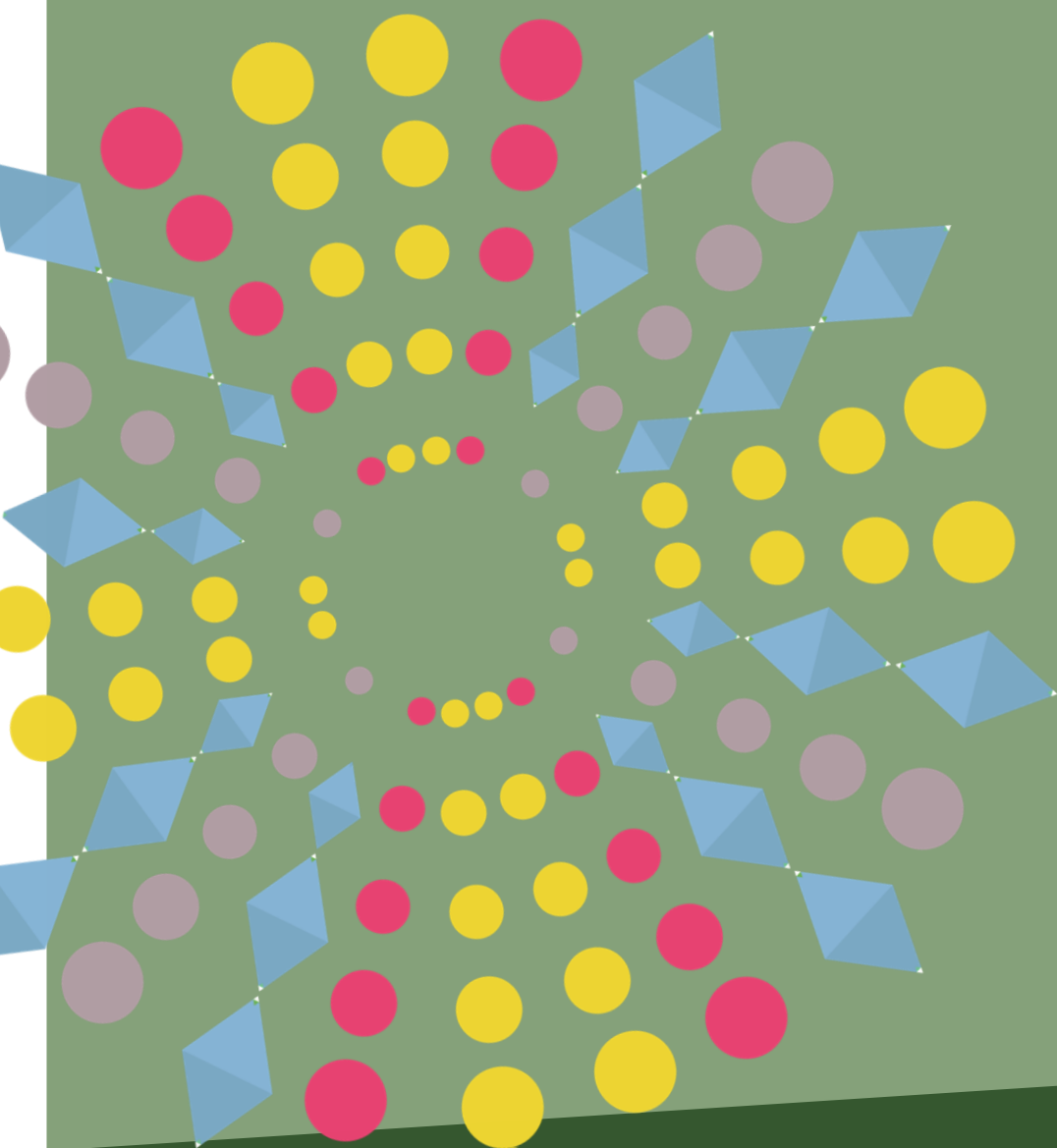

- Following confirmation from the Government that VAT will apply to independent school fees from April 2025, after school clubs will also be subject to VAT at the 20% standard rate as they include an element of education.
- Clubs will start during the week commencing Monday 15th September and will continue until Thursday 4th December 2025. There will be a two week break due in clubs from Monday 27th October to Friday 7th November due to Half Term and staff straining days. Clubs will resume Monday 10th November.
- Bookings for clubs will open online from 7pm on Friday 5th September and close at 10am on Wednesday 10th September 2025.
- Children that are attending a club at 4:30 and not attending a club beforehand, will go to after school care.
- Try outs for Gym Squad will take place during the first gymnastics session of the school year. If successful, the pupil will be invited to join the gym squad. Any questions regarding this, please email the PE department. More information will be available via the sports noticeboard in the reception area nearer the time.
- Cancellation policy – Please note that should you wish to withdraw your daughter from a club after the first week, half a term's notice is required or half a term will be charged instead of notice.
 - Should The Cavendish School cancel a club, you will be refunded for that session.
 - Absence from an after school club does not qualify for a refund.



The teacher will use their hands, and occasionally a foot or knee, to illustrate a concept to a student or to adjust parts of a student's body (especially with the younger students).

Rope posture often requires adjusting the rib-cage and the buttock area simultaneously and it is sometimes necessary to touch the inner thigh, especially with younger students.



The Cavendish School recognises that such physical contact is a potentially complex area, and the School also fully recognises its responsibilities for safeguarding students and teachers and for protecting their welfare.


